

Divide and Conquer Free Motion Quilting

** You need a sewing machine with the ability to drop the feed dogs, and the appropriate foot for free motion quilting. This is usually called a darning foot. Needle down feature is very helpful, too.

Bright colored threads that will show well on a black background. Two colors would be fine. Bobbins wound to match top thread.

Quilting gloves would be helpful. Machingers, Fons and Porter Gloves, Grabaroods are a few brands. Machingers are easiest to find. Please don't bring other grippy gadgets. I can't help you learn with those.

A doodle tablet, or sketchbook for the initial practice, and a pencil. I like mechanical pencils best.

Snips or scissors. Seam ripper (sorry...)

**The quilt sandwich, already marked, will be in your \$10 kit. I will also include a spool of fun variegated thread for you to try, a handout of quilting stitches and a list of places you can find tutorials and samples on the internet.
