



Lucille Ball Portrait Class - Kay Donges

I will be teaching the basic techniques of layering and fusing fabrics to make this celebrity portrait. You should be able to complete the face, hair, and blouse in class. Applying the border and finishing the quilt will be done at home. So no sewing machine or thread is needed.

You will be supplied with a full size colored pattern and a full size drawing on transparency film to use for tracing your pattern parts and aligning your parts while fusing. I will also provide parchment paper to use while assembling your pieces. (You can bring an appliqué pressing sheet if you have one)

I also will be demonstrating how I break down a photo to create my pattern. I will also show you how to print a large pattern on your home printer.

Supplies

Fabric kits for the face and hair will be available for purchase \$14

Fat quarter of fabric for background behind portrait - 50s looking fabric works well

Scissors with a sharp point - I prefer Karen Kay Buckley Perfect Scissors, 6-Inch (Blue Handles)

Shades Textiles Soft Fuse Premium Roll 18"x 3 yd fusible

Sharpie fine tip black markers (2)

Number 2 pencil

Tweezers

Iron and ironing surface (if possible)

Light box (if possible)
