

PAPER PIECING

We will be making an easy 16" Paper Piecing Table Mat in class. It can also be made into a 16" X 48" Table Runner. It mostly scraps from your stash! The papers needed for Paper Piecing will be supplied to you.

SUPPLY LIST

Fabric: Background: 4 - 6" squares (my dots)

1. 4 - 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " X 5" (my green)
2. 2 - 3" squares
3. 4 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
4. 2 - 3" squares
5. 4 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ "
6. 2 - 3" X wof strips (border)

Backing & Batting: 18" square

For table runner just multiply supplies by 3. Backing & Batting: 18" X 50".

Sewing Needs:

- All your usual sewing supplies.
- Thin ruler
- Template plastic or thin cardboard – 8" long & approximately 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 3" wide.
- Clear ruler 8" to 12" with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " mark
- Pins – flat head pins work best
- Optional but highly recommended: small iron & pad for your table.
- Optional: Add-a-quarter ruler
- Optional: Glue stick
